- increasing numbers of students being driven to school – currently around 70 per cent (Metropolitan Household Travel Survey 1999)
- decreasing numbers of children walking and cycling
- increasing rates of obesity in children and adults
- increased traffic congestion around schools

- promote more active and healthy lifestyles
- reduce traffic congestion around schools

- highlights the benefits of walking, cycling and using public transport
- offers a range of initiatives to help change travel behaviour
- provides an Orientation Day for teachers with TRT supplied
